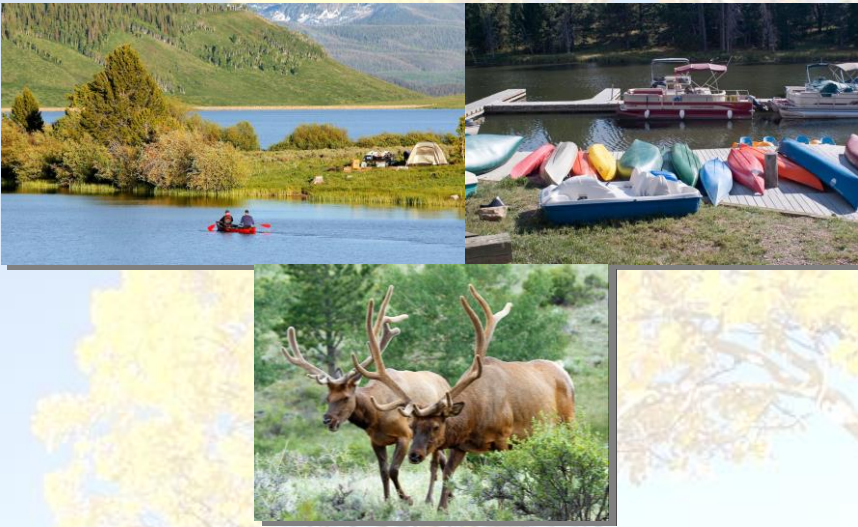


Colorado ECKANKAR Campout

DIRECTIONS:

About 185 miles from central Denver, approximately 3.5 hours of driving time. Take I-70 west for 55 miles, merge onto CO-9N via exit 205 toward Silverthorne. Travel north for 37 miles. Turn left onto US-40 W/Park Ave. in Kremmling. Travel 54 miles to County Road 129 in Steamboat Springs. Turn north and drive 25 miles. The visitor center is on the left hand side of the road.

WHAT TO BRING:

Plenty of water and water bottle, food for meals and snacks, eating utensils, camera, journal, musical instruments, camping gear, sunblock, bug repellent, walking/hiking shoes, swimsuit, towels, jacket, and windbreaker.
